

## Antagon/Protagon COVID-19 Concept

### Co-Laboratory Winterwerft 2021

#### Feedback as talked before:

#### General Description

The Care Team has been created in order to establish the necessary safety measures to reduce any potential danger of the current pandemic before, during, and after the working Co-Laboratory Winterwerft 2021 that takes place between the 18<sup>th</sup> of January to 14<sup>th</sup> of February. Hence, this document intends to enable both permanent and temporary residents at the Cultural Space Protagon e.V. Orber Str. 57 Frankfurt am Main to be aware of the safety measures and concept for our collective living situation during the working process. Furthermore, Antagon/Protagon team states that all procedures taken for safety matters are attentively based on the local regulations and updates of the state of Hessen in relation to the Co-Laboratory Winterwerft 2021. Attentively, we follow the current rules established by the Corona-Quarantäneverordnung Hessen update from 9.1.2021.

#### Safety Measures

First of all, we affirm that a pre-inspection on the participants' historical background regarding the COVID-19 infection is required before they arrive. We check, for example, background trip, physical distance and what the participants' attitude towards the virus. For the Care Team, it is necessary to know how serious the participants take the current pandemic. The safety measures will be sent to all participants who are staying at the Cultural Space Protagon e.V regardless of their status either as a permanent or a temporal resident.

The Co-Laboratory Winterwerft 2021 participants are divided into two clear categories; those artists and technical workers coming from countries that are considered as risk areas and those ones coming from non-risk countries that are considered non-risk areas and Germany. For these two categories, there are different approaches upon their arrivals, based on the recent rules restrictions of entry to Germany. As you are responsible of keeping these rules, we ask you to read them carefully.

You will find the information if you are from a risk area or not, and how to proceed. We have summed it up for you here some of the main points. But, we still ask you to read carefully the information on the website. Likewise, we also ask you to be aware that the rules may change, for example, areas that are considered risk areas, may change to non-risk areas. So, it is wise to check the status of your country departure prior to some days before the trip.

#### Participants from risk areas

If you have have been to a risk area within the last 10 days (it is okay to travel through a risk area, but not to spend the night there), you have to register and make a test **48h before arriving or right after your arrival in Germany. Regarding the test, we remind the necessity to take a PCR test and not any sort of fast-test. PCR testing is considered the “gold standard” in SARS-CoV-2 detection.**

If a Covid-19 test (PCR) is not available in your area, the participant can take a Covid-19 test right after the entry at Centogene Clinic at the Airport in Frankfurt am Main. In this case, please, enter in the given website <https://www.centogene.com/corona.html> and make a registration, then finally book a simple test that costs 59 Euros. The test result takes up to 12 hours to be delivered via e-mail. After taking the test and entering Germany, the participants should go directly to their quarantine space in our collective space and stay for 10 days, however due to our working process, we advise the participants to undergo a second test after the fifth day of quarantine. If a second test is negative, the participant can

then join our 'Covid-19 FREE bubble'.

We remind that during the required five days of quarantine at our space, the participants are kindly asked to wear a mask while walking inside the main building and keep at least 1,5 m distance of the other participants in the outdoor space. By this time, the Care Team is in charge of providing all the facilities for the participants to go through their quarantine time such as separate beds, toilets, hygiene stations and meal service.

All tests will be refunded by the Co-Laboratory Winterwerft 2021 organization. Both permanent and temporary residents should send their results and receipts for the Care Team so that they can get refunded. Nevertheless, the budget for the test is 80 Euros, if the test price is above the budget, please, contact the Care Team as soon as possible. Moreover, we also kindly ask all the participants coming from a foreign country to start a quarantine of five days before their entry to Germany. Of course, this topic is considered in our pre-inspection, but we emphasize here our wish for this sensitive attitude towards our working process.

**Note: We inform that the Centogene Clinic at the airport in Frankfurt am Main is not currently testing people who are not flight passengers. So, if you are coming to from a risk area to Germany by car or train, you should definitely try to take a test (PCR) before traveling to Germany. If a PCR Covid-19 test is not available in your area you should contact the Care Team as soon as possible and try to find other possibilities.**

### **Participants from non-risk areas and Germany**

People from non-risk areas or countries are not obligated to make tests and quarantine when entering the German state. Nevertheless, we ask both participants coming from non-risk areas and those ones coming from Germany to make a covid-19 test (PCR “gold standard” in SARS-CoV-2 detection) before entering the Cultural Space Protagon e.V. This is clearly in order to lower the chance of any infection inside the space. **Likewise the participants coming from risk areas, we also kindly ask all the participants coming from non-risk areas to start a quarantine of five days before their entry to Germany. This orientation is also meant for those participants coming from Germany before they arrive at our collective space.** Once again we emphasize our wish for this sensitive attitude towards our working process.

Participants coming from a non-risk area and Germany should take their tests in advance, ideally two days before their arrival at our main gate, because we have a limited number of isolation rooms for people waiting for their test results. But if you still have to wait for your test result inside our collective space, we are able to provide the necessary structure. So, while waiting for the result in our collective space, we kindly ask you to wear masks and keep the required distance from other participants until you have your negative test result and join our Covid-19 free bubble.

If a PCR Covid-19 test is not available in your area you can make the test in Frankfurt, nevertheless the Centogene Clinic at the airport is currently focusing on those travelers coming from risk areas due to the high demand of tests. It means that depending on your arrival date you may be asked to take the test in another test center. So, if you are coming from a non-risk area to Germany, please, contact the Care Team in order to find other possibilities to get tested in Frankfurt. If you are coming from Germany, please, get tested ideally two days before your arrival to our collective space. Under such a circumstance, we emphasize that according to the pandemic current situation, the best option will be for those participants coming from a non-risk area countries to go through the test before their trip to Germany. Coming from a non-risk area with a negative test, the participant has direct access to join our 'Covid-19 FREE bubble'. Nor quarantine neither a second test is required for this category. All tests will be refunded by the Care Team. Both permanent and temporary residents should

send their results and receipts for the Care Team so that they can get refunded. Nevertheless, the budget for the test is 80 Euros, if the test price is above the budget, please, contact the Care Team as soon as possible.

### **Procedures in the Collective Space**

The Care Team states that we look forward to seeing all the participants in our collective space. Therefore, we understand the necessity of having a safety guideline that aims to keep all of our participants to Co-Laboratory Winterwerft 2021 safe. For this reason, we ask for understanding, patience and trust on our safety approach.

### **During the work residence**

\*All Participants:

- All participants are advised to stay in our collective space during Co-Laboratory Winterwerft 2021. Participants are advised not to leave our collective space, unless they have a very strong reason to do so. For example, serious issues in the family or health problems that may lead to a consultation at the doctor. But still, any situation that may lead a participant to leave our collective space must be negotiated with the Care Team.
- Participants must fill out a form with contact information when they enter to the Cultural Space Protagon e.V. Orber Str. 57.
- Participants still under quarantine rules should always wear a mask inside the main building and keep the required distance when at outdoor areas.

**In any case of a positive test inside of our collective space, the activities will immediately be suspended and the Care Team will report the situation to the local authorities and take the necessary measures to protect all the other participants.** Moreover, we affirm that our collective space is prepared with at least two isolation rooms in case of a positive diagnose of a participant with covid-19. The rooms are prepared with a basic structure so that the individual may have some autonomy. In addition to that, the Care Team is responsible for the meals and all care that those participants may need during a quarantine time in our collective space. In conclusion, we state that this document assembles coherent and functional safety measures that may enable all the participants to build together a common understanding of our current situation before the challenge of making the Co-Laboratory Winterwerft 2021 happens in this moment of COVID-19 pandemic.

### **Fast guideline!**

1. Check if your departure country is under the category of risk area or not. <https://www.auswaertiges-amt.de/en/einreiseundaufenthalt/coronavirus>
2. If yes, you are required to register online and then either take a Covid-19 test (PCR) 48 hour before your trip in your area or right after your entry to Germany at Centogene Clinic. For registration and booking please follow the link: <https://www.centogene.com/corona.html> .
3. If you are not coming from a risk area, you do not need to register on the given website, but the local airport and international airlines may ask you to fill up a form with your personal information and destination for safety measures. So, it is wise to have all details with you.
4. We kindly ask you to start a quarantine of at least five days before your trip to Germany or before your arrival at our collective space (those coming from Germany).
5. Remember that those coming from a risk area are supposed to go through a two tests method plus quarantine rules and then join our 'Covid-19 free bubble' if the second

test is negative. While the participants coming from non-risk areas and Germany are required by the Care Team to undergo through a one test method and then join our 'Covid-19 free bubble' if the first test is negative.

6. So, if you are coming from a non-risk area to Germany, please, contact the Care Team in order to find other possibilities to get tested in Frankfurt.
7. If you are coming from Germany, please, get tested ideally two days before your arrival to our collective space.
8. The Care Team is currently available through phone calls and e-mails to help the participants to arrive safely at our collective space and answer questions. Please, contact us if you have any problem concerning problems with your arrival dates, potential flight cancelation, any sort of misunderstanding or miscommunication. The Care Team is here to soothe this process and help you to have a great experience during our Co-Laboratory Winterwerft 2021.
